


















BRIEFING NOTES

- Hosted in Diepsloot, Gauteng by WASSUP (Water, Amenities, Sanitation Services Upgrade Programme) and DACN (Diepsloot Arts & Culture Network), in collaboration with Healthabitat Sanitation Studio.
- Facilitated in South Africa by Sticky Situations.
