Stantec provides professional consulting services in planning, engineering, architecture, interior design, landscape architecture, surveying, environmental sciences, project management, and project economics. The global design firm thrives, posting year over year gross revenues close to \$2.25 billion, generated through three areas of business: buildings, energy and resources, and infrastructure.

Originally founded in Canada, Stantec now has over 250 North American and international locations, including 20 in California. Stantec employs over 15,000 people.

Stantec is directly involved in projects to strengthen North American integration through its work on improving the design of border crossings between the U.S. and Canada and between the U.S. and Mexico.

One of Stantec's border crossing projects includes capacity and systems improvements at the Blue Water Bridge Plaza, a critical gateway which links Sarnia, Ontario and Port Huron, Michigan across the Saint Clair River. An average of 14,000 vehicles cross the bridge each day, including as many as 6,000 trucks. Border plaza improvements accommodate the



crossing of increased passenger and truck traffic.

Stantec uses their North American talents to make the continent's trade even more efficient.
